Support group for women under threat

A support group for women who feel threatened or controlled in their relationship is being run by the Kew Centre of Relationships Australia Victoria (RAV) from next month.

Assistant Centre Manager, Patrizia Favorito, said the group would enable women to share their fears and concerns in a supportive environment with other women who had similar experiences.

She said a range of topics would be covered including understanding family relationships, safety issues for family members, parenting, the impact of threatening and controlling behaviour on children, and self care.

“Participants will have the opportunity to discuss what makes healthy relationships and learn new ways of helping their families become more responsible and respectful.”

Ms Favorito said a range of useful information, services and resources would be available.

Starting on 20 July, the group will be run on Tuesdays from 10 am to noon. It is free of charge.
